### Anthem Schools Trust supports its digital strategy with a unified, cloud-first Meraki solution from Redway Networks.

Anthem Schools Trust has rolled out a cloud-first Cisco Meraki network, designed and installed by Redway Networks, to provide an easy-to-manage network across multiple locations for delivering seamless learning experiences across its schools. The Meraki WiFi6 and next-generation switching is providing secure, reliable wireless connectivity to eight schools within the trust on one network with 6,714 students connected.

Anthem Schools Trust is one of the most well-established schools' trusts in the UK. For more than a decade, it has been running a group of state-funded, non-selective schools in the East Midlands, London and the Thames Valley. As a multi-academy trust (MAT) Anthem is responsible for ensuring that the children at its schools receive the education they deserve to realise their incredible potential. Information technology plays a vital role in all aspects of education for the Trust, as it not only enhances e-learning at its geographically spread schools, but also promotes collaboration and communication.

Anthem Schools Trust was facing the ongoing challenge of ensuring robust, connected experiences for its schools who all had a different legacy wireless network. Anthem's key education specialists regularly taught at each school site and the slow WiFi was impacting lesson time. Its IT team was also having to manage several school networks with limited resources, whilst prioritising the student experience.

Recognising the importance of a standardised approach to IT so that each school could benefit from an agreed level of service, Anthem decided to upgrade eight of its schools to a future-proofed network that would support its digital vision.



## Future-Proofing and Cloud Networking required

Ross Weeks, Head of IT & Digital Strategy for Anthem Schools Trust says: "A trust the size of ours needs standardisation with not pockets of success, but a blanket of success. Our focus is to provide the best technology for delivering exceptional learning experiences to our students whilst delivering efficiency. We wanted a cloud-first, centrally controlled network without the need of on-premises controllers that could be managed through a single dashboard. We also wanted superior wireless coverage and capacity for supporting our high-density school environments. I'd worked with Redway Networks in the past and knew that Redway had the knowledge and skill set in the education-sector to provide the professional services and next-generation products we required to get our schools on the same, high-performing network infrastructure."

Ross says: "The static classroom has been replaced by more diverse learning styles and we're providing better technology to support a curriculum with less time in the classroom so we can point the resource where it's needed. Having a unified approach means configuration and deployment of our switching and network infrastructure is now simple. Before Meraki updating all our switches could take days, but this task is now accomplished quickly and ensures the network remains up to date with the latest security features."

## Anthem, Redway and Meraki make a great partnership

Ross says: "I have regular operational meetings with key members of staff who report back much faster WiFi speeds with none of the login issues we were seeing before Meraki. Staff can now access their digital teaching resources from any school site. Having Meraki's external access points means we can extend learning outside of the classrooms. This is especially important to our primary school children in delivering science lessons outside in the fresh air. We can also take live pupil registers for fire drills in external locations which has improved student safety."

Ross concludes: "We're committed to delivering the best possible educational outcomes and learning experiences across all our schools. We've built a great partnership with Redway Networks who've been instrumental in taking us through a journey that we are now able to replicate throughout all our schools."
