The school had been trying to make the most of its mixed estate for WiFi and networking which was outdated, under-supported and failing to keep up the online demands of the school's 1600 students and 1500+ network devices.

Rob Fuller, Head of IT Systems at Great Baddow School says: "Following the Covid pandemic we'd invested heavily in new laptops and equipment, but not in our underlying infrastructure.

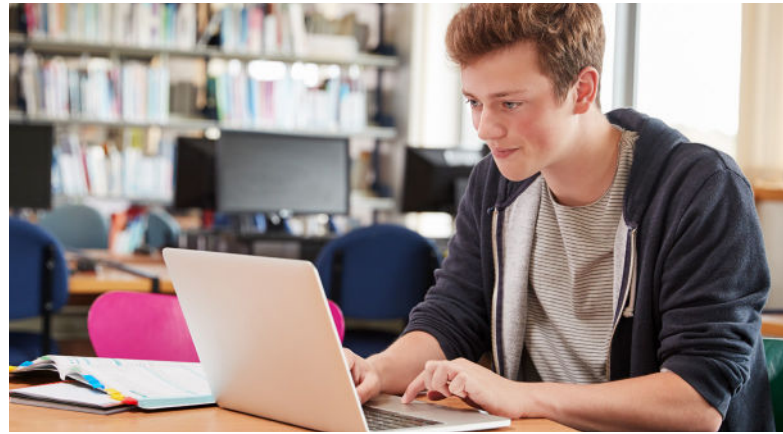
## Existing WiFi can't support the schools' numerous devices

Rob continues: "As we adopted more school devices, we started to see major creaks in our network which was a mix of Ubiquity WiFi and ad-hoc network switches. We also had no single management plane so identifying network issues was time consuming. We needed to upgrade to a more superior wired and wireless network and that offered better performance and could be managed and maintained easily through a cloud-based solution."

## Cambium's cloud-managed network delivers results

Redway Networks and the school's IT team worked closely together using Ekahau's WiFi planning software to create a predictive wireless design that would provide multi-gigabit connectivity to the school's classrooms. The wireless installation included 81 Cambium cnPilot Enterprise WiFi 6 cloud-based access points, 69 x Cambium cnMatrix next-gen edge switches and 2 x HPE Aruba core switches to provide a resilient backbone for the network. The network is managed using Cambium's cnMaestro cloud-management system which means any network issues can be highlighted and dealt with by Rob's team quickly.

Great Baddow's whole edge network is now cloud-based and more robust with much faster WiFi and complete network visibility.
